Bible Released Time... what's this all about?

If you are taking a moment to read this, you're doing exactly what I would do! My wife, Kathy and I raised four children, and when they wanted to go anywhere, we wanted to know who they would be with and what they would be doing. Any good parent would! In short, this is an elective "Bible story time" for children who, with parental consent, are excused from school for one class period, once per month. In Tennessee, thousands of children enroll in Bible Released Time programs each year. But since this is a "religious program", you may still have some questions about what your child will be taught and who we are. So let me share a little about us ...

First of all, Bible Released Time is sponsored by Children's Bible Ministries of East Tennessee (CBM). CBM is based right here in the Tri-Cities area at Camp Ta-Pa-Win-Go, just outside Elizabethton. We are a respected, non-profit children's ministry, providing school programs and affordable summer camps for children since the 1940's. Many area parents and grandparents can still recall our monthly school visits and flannel board Bible stories in their school auditorium or gym when they grew up! Now held off school property at neighborhood churches (bus ride provided), the program continues to grow each year with over 2000 students enrolled last year in the east Tennessee area!

In 2020, Tennessee enacted a new law making Bible Released Time accessible for all students. The Sullivan County Board of Education can allow the program but does not sponsor or endorse it in any way. The additional form attached is to make sure you are aware of this and also needs your signature. Classes each month will take place during a non-tested subject time and will be considered an excused absence from school.

Our program is for students in grades 3-5. Kids enjoy our classes whether they go to church regularly or if they know very little about the Bible! Our presentations are not "preachy"... we just teach the Bible in a fun and creative way that your child can learn from. You may also appreciate knowing that CBM does not represent any church or denomination. We focus on Bible basics in our classes. Denominational teachings, we feel, should be left to parents and their church.

If you think learning about the Bible is something your child would benefit from, we encourage you to let them give it a try! We often find that many of the students who miss the first class decide they want to go after they hear their friends talking about it, so we encourage you to send these forms back right away, so they don't miss the first trip!

To enroll your child, fill out both forms and return to your school.
